From The Vaults

As the National Eucharistic Revival enters its final year, it's appropriate to recall a page from the Autumn 1957 edition of Marian Helpers Bulletin, entitled "When You Miss One Holy Communion."

"It is well occasionally to consider what you lose every morning that you pass up Holy Communion, readers were advised. A list followed:

- 1. You miss a personal visit with Jesus, author of all spiritual energy and of all holiness.
- 2. You lose a special increase of sanctifying grace, which makes your soul more pleasing to God.
- 3. You lose a quota of sacramental grace, which entitles you to special help in times of temptation and in the discharge of your daily duties.
- 4. You lose a precious opportunity of having all your venial sins wiped away.
- 5. You miss the special preserving influence which each Holy Communion confers against the fires of passion.
- 6. You miss the opportunity of having remitted a part, or all, of the temporal punishment due to your sins.
- 7. You lose the spiritual joy, the sweetness, and particular comfort that come from a fervent Holy Communion.
- 8. You lose part of the glory that your body might enjoy at its resurrection on the Last Day.
- 9. You lose the greater degree of glory you would possess in Heaven for all eternity.
- 10. You may lose: a) Complete victory over some fault or passion; b) Some particular grace long prayed for; c) The conversion or salvation of some soul; d) Deliverance of a relative or friend from Purgatory; e) Many graces for others, both the living and the dead.

The article concluded, "Will a few extra minutes of sleep repay you for all these losses?"



Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

I craved four things as a teenager: success in sports, food, fun and the attention of popular people. However, I noticed that as I acquired them, I was more unsatisfied than before. So, I'd strive even more energetically, achieve more, and the sense of emptiness was greater still. These four things started to feel like burdens or even curses. Soon after, I encountered Christ in my high school youth group. Experiencing his love was totally different than anything those four things previously produced. It produced a lasting happiness.

Jesus utters a kind of four-fold curse in this week's Gospel of Saint Luke's "woes": "Woe to you who are rich...who are filled now...who laugh now...who are well-spoken of" (cf. Luke 6:24-26). How marvelous that these correspond perfectly to the four things that obsessed my teenage soul: riches, food, laughter and good reputation. The "woes" the Lord speaks are warnings: when those things are the purpose of your life, you'll be miserable. He is saying, "You'll be happy, or blessed, in the measure that these things do not determine the shape of our lives, and the kingdom of God does."

To some degree, we're all spiritual teenagers, addicted to one or more of those four "woes." How splendid that the Lord wants his to bless us — that is, to satisfy us, make us laugh with joy, and in the kingdom of God, offer us what will truly satisfy us. But first let's admit what is causing our "woes."



Fasting: Catholics 18-59 years of age, who are in good health, are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On all the weekdays of Lent, the U.S. Bishops strongly encourage the faithful to participate in Mass and to observe a self-imposed fast. The law of fasting allows only one full meal a day, but does not prohibit taking some food in the morning and evening. Customarily, the two smaller "collations," when considered together, should not equal the main meal and ideally should be eaten only if needed to maintain one's strength.

Abstinence: All Catholics 14 years of age and older are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent, unless the Friday is a solemnity.



To obtain the Catholic rate at St. James Catholic School and/or St. Patrick Catholic High School, one must be a registered and participating family who regularly contributes to Saint James Parish (using checks, parish envelopes or electronic giving). Each school year, parents must bring a subsidy form from the school to the parish office for the pastor to sign in order to receive the subsidized tuition rate.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

Parents are responsible before God to choose appropriate schooling for each of their children. Our task, as a parish community, is to assist parents as best we can with the tools they need to raise their children as good Catholics. Each year, our parish is assessed a certain percentage of our Sunday collection to be allocated to our local Catholic schools, St. James Catholic School and St. Patrick Catholic High School. As such, Saint James Parish has money set aside in the 2025/2026 budget for our registered contributing families to help with Catholic elementary and high school tuition costs.

At Saint James, our policy is also to set aside a proportional amount to support our faith formation programs for parents who choose public schools or home schooling for their children.

We follow a "needs based" policy. Both schools utilize FACTS, an organization that specializes in determining the financial need of each family. The Tuition Assistance application process is now open. There is a processing fee.






